





WHAT IS WANDSWORTH TOWN BID?

Wandsworth Town Business Improvement District (BID) is a not-for-profit partnership, elected by local businesses to invest in local improvements. Wandsworth Town BID was established in 2017 through a democratic ballot process and the services provided are additional to those delivered by the statutory authorities. There are currently more than 300 BIDs in the UK, working to support and invest in town centres.

THE BID RULES.

All businesses in the defined BID area with a rateable value of more than £15,000 are required to pay a BID levy. This fee is equal to 1.62% of the rateable value. Tenants at Southside Shopping Centre are offered a relief of 40% considering other charges that apply. Charities are exempt from paying the BID levy.

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Our Business Crime Reduction Partnership (BCRP) had its most successful year by far. Record levels of engagement with local businesses, over 240 prolific offenders identified, and 11 offenders banned by the Police from entering Wandsworth Town.
- Connected with over 10,000 locals and visitors across Instagram and the We Are Wandsworth Town app to drive footfall to the town centre.
- Record attendances of 7,515 at Old York Road
 Unplugged in June 2024 and 13,324 at The
 Wandsworth Town Christmas Festival in November 2024.
- Sponsored the Food & Culture Awards 2024, and secured wins and strong publicity for two Wandsworth Town businesses.
- Hosted our very first Wandsworth Connected event at Sambrook's Brewery for local businesses. The keynote networking event looked at the power of Al in supporting small businesses and driving innovation.
- Curated our first ever Black History Month event for the community, featuring a range of free activities, including live ballet performances, a fashion show, and a powerful photography exhibition.
